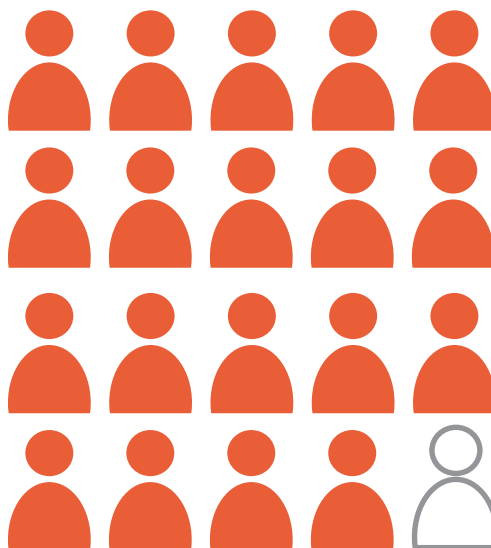

OUR PROGRAMS IN ACTION

Impact Model

A holistic approach to youth development that keep kids on track by providing students with 60 additional days of academic instruction per year. Every day, our impact model provides every child access to an hour of academic assistance and homework help, physical fitness and health education, and academic enrichment programs.

60 additional days of academic instruction per year

Family Strengthening Initiative

Based on the belief that strengthening the entire family unit will put our kids on a greater path to success, this program model focuses on educating, empowering, and equipping the parents in our community to improve their family's education, finances and health.

Early Literacy Program

Our Early Literacy Program addresses educational gaps that exist and provides targeted, during-the-school-day intervention at the Club and school sites throughout the city. Our goal is to ensure our kids are reading at grade level, and on track for educational success.

College Bound & Teen Services

We support students through their high school careers, graduation and beyond by providing mentors that help build a custom plan for their futures. Our goal is to ensure that every graduating senior has a plan for their future and a path forward to thrive.
